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Tollhaus Arts Center Karlsruhe

The conversion of the existing, landmarked buildings was completed in September 2008. Tollhaus now calls its own newly designed, generous foyer areas, dressing rooms for artists, lounge areas and offices. It was possible to start the 2008/2009 season as scheduled using the existing auditorium. As the final building stage, a new auditorium that will seat 750 is now under construction as an extension to the existing buildings. A glass joint will connect this "tent house" to the existing buildings. Contrary to the existing solid sandstone walls and tile roofs of the existing buildings, this facade will be light, transparent, shining from inside; translucent plastic panels will cover the whole structure. Completing the ensemble, a cross wing accommodating the dressing rooms for the artists and stage side rooms will also be included under the tent house roof. This wing will eventually be overgrown by a "fur" of climbing plants.



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Addition Waghäusel Town Hall

3rd price in competition
Stadt Waghäusel

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The addition is planned north of the existing building – to provide a counterpart to the residential housing opposite, as required by the town's typology – and to make this addition perceptible towards the public space. The adoption of brickwork for the addition's extremely cubic exterior with its even volume and calm surfaces generates an overall ensemble. The present building diagonal is broken intentionally and turned into an orthogonal network of two buildings set at an angle. A new quiet patio will be created in between as recreation area for employees.

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78 additional residential units in 9 houses will be built along the western edge of the 100 year old Gartenstadt cooperative in Karlsruhe-Rüppurr. The three-story terraces will be aligned along the "green wall" shielding off the main road. The apartments will mainly face south and include generous terraces or balconies. Elevators will make the most apartments accessible to disabled individuals. In spite of reasonably dense compacting, a green and leafy quarter will develop in interplay with the western gardens of Heckenweg.
